

Dear Pastor/Father/Rabbi/Imam _____:

We are writing to you as members of Branch ____ in _____, of the Ukrainian National Women's League of America (UNWLA). UNWLA is the oldest Ukrainian women's organization in the United States, having celebrated our 100th anniversary in 2025. Our signature campaign, as we join together with our communities to support Ukraine as she defends herself and western democracy against russian aggression, is the **Children Praying for Children** campaign. This campaign calls on all children in our broader communities to come together to pray for the children of Ukraine—those who have suffered injury and displacement during war and especially, those who have been abducted by russian troops and forcibly transferred to russian territory. While the plight of Ukrainian children is particularly meaningful to our Ukrainian community, we believe that the wellbeing of children is one that resonates with each and every one of us, throughout our various and distinct communities.

With that in mind, we ask that you join with us between our campaign kick-off date of October 17 through World Children's Day on November 20, 2026 by participating in or creating an event during which the children of _____ pray especially for Ukraine's children. Ideally, we hope your community can participate in a multidenominational event being organized by _____ (see contact info below). If you are unable to do that, we would be very grateful if you held an event at _____. This can range from a dedicated prayer at your regularly-scheduled worship service or a separate event with multiple activities planned around the theme of Children Praying for Children. Should you prefer an independent event, we only ask that you let us know, so that we can make note of it. In 2024 (the first for this campaign), we had 12 events take place across the country. Last year, the campaign grew to over 50 events nationwide. We hope to exceed that number, since we well-recognize that we gain strength from the support of one another.
