Starting November 12, 2024, and running until March 31, 2025, UNWLA is launching a new fundraising campaign to provide essential aid to Ukrainian women in the military. Building on the success of last year's effort, which raised \$138,000 for winter uniforms and warm supplies, this year's campaign sets an ambitious goal of \$200,000 to expand our impact and ensure these courageous women are equipped for the challenges ahead.

"Our mission is to stand by these women as they fight not just for Ukraine, but for democracy and freedom," said Natalia Pawlenko, UNWLA President. "Every dollar donated helps us provide the critical resources they need to stay strong on the battlefield."
